What should I do if I am concerned about my child's development?

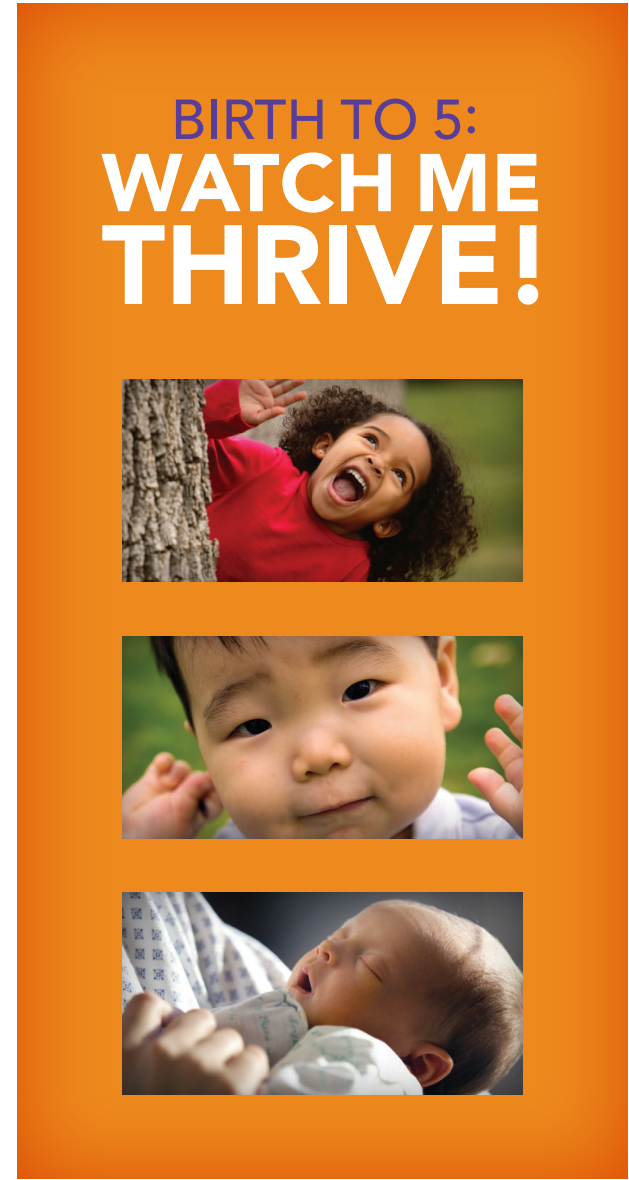
Don't wait! You know your child best. Talk to your child's doctor and share screening results and completed milestone checklists.

If you or the doctor is still concerned,

- Ask the doctor for a referral for further evaluation, and
- Contact your state's early intervention program (if your child is under 3) or public school (if your child is 3 or older). Find the phone number for your state's early intervention program by visiting www.cdc.gov/Concerned.
