Each year, the National Center for Health Statistics (NCHS) releases data in a variety of formats, including scientific reports, tables, dashboards, and other visualizations. These health statistics allow us to:

- Document the health status for the entire population and subgroups
- Identify disparities in health status and use of healthcare services by race and ethnicity, socioeconomic status, region, and other population characteristics
- Identify health problems
- Support biomedical and health services research
- Provide information for making changes in public policies and programs
- Evaluate the impact of health policies and programs
